

Abstract submission guidelines

An abstract is required for your poster or short talk presentation and it should clearly state the unique elements of the work, and concisely state all important findings of the study.

Please follow these instructions.

1. The abstract should be 250 - 500 words and should describe the work's primary objective, basic methods used to reach that objective, results obtained, and implications of the work;
2. The names of authors should follow immediately under the title all in one line. The name of institution, city and country should be in lower case, following immediately after the authors, on a different line;
3. Define abbreviations and acronyms the first time used;
4. Do not include graphs, tables and references in the abstract;
5. Correspondence information should follow the abstract and should be preceded by "Correspondence". It should include name, address (including postal code), telephone numbers, e-mail address, and website
6. Indicate the person that will be presenting in case the abstract is accepted for short oral presentation
7. Submission of the abstract in Microsoft Word format is preferred
8. Submissions will be reviewed and authors will be notified about the acceptance for presentation by poster or short talk
